Contraception and infertility recall answers

1. Contain hormones to inhibit FSH production so eggs don't mature.
2. Injection, implant or skin patch
3. Condoms and diaphragms
4. Prevent the implantation of an embryo in the uterus lining, release a hormone.
5. Kill or disable sperm
6. Abstaining (not having) sexual intercourse when an egg may be in the fallopian tube.
7. Sperm duct/fallopian tube cut and tied.
8. FSH and LH
9. Emotionally and physically stressful, success rate isn't high, can lead to multiple births which can be a risk to mothers and babies.
