

Population Density	Average number of people living in a place per km ²
Biome	A large area with a similar climate, plants and animals
Physical features	Natural environment including; coasts, rivers, mountains and biomes.
Urban area	A built up area (large town or city)
Inequality	Unequal sharing of wealth in a society
Diverse	Asia has more people, more cultures and a large range of climates and environments.

Asia Facts:

- Largest continent
- It covers 1/3 of the worlds total land area
- Current population is 4.5 billion people
- Consists of 48 countries
- It as over 2300 languages
- It has 12 landlocked countries
- Experiences volcanoes, Earthquakes and Tsunami's
- Asia is only separated from North America by 82km of water called the Bering Strait.
- Highest point in the world – Mount Everest 8849m above sea level.
