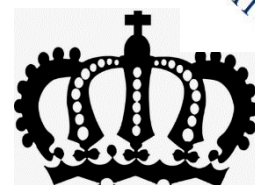

I hope you have a lovely (long) weekend!

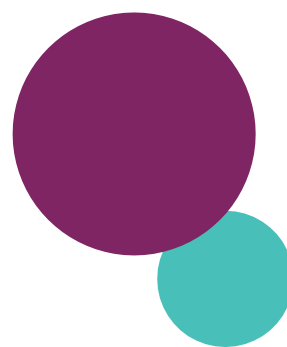

Changes to The uniform policy

A reminder, Non-black trainers, boots above the ankle, daps, sandals or shoes without backs are not allowed; all heels should be no more than 3cm.

Ankle boots are allowed but must be worn under trousers. **Shoes or trainers must be completely black, including any logos, toe caps, laces and soles. Shoes or trainers must have a leather style upper; canvas footwear is not permitted.**

Polish School Visit

On Tuesday 25th April, 38 Polish pupils and 6 staff visited our school. They were from Lodz in Poland and were on an educational visit to the UK. Our newly appointed Welcome Ambassadors took them on a tour of the school, sat with them in classes so they could observe lessons, and then took them into PE, where they could play table tennis and dodgeball.

Mr Smith who arranged the visit said,

"We also gave presentations on the history of Swindon and our own school, and then we learned about their town, Lodz, and what they do at their schools. After a music and dance recital they had lunch with our pupils, before moving on to London.

"Their organiser, Adam Kazimierczak, said a huge thank you for what he described as a great experience, and is inviting us to visit them in the future.

"It was also an excellent experience for our pupils, meeting children with other backgrounds, learning about other cultures and ways of doing things, and getting on so well with the visitors. I'm very proud of how every pupil involved made them feel so welcome. They are a credit to our school."

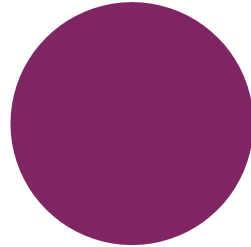

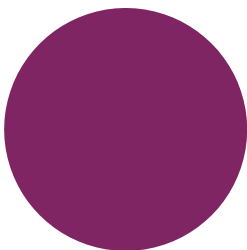
Why We Should Attend School

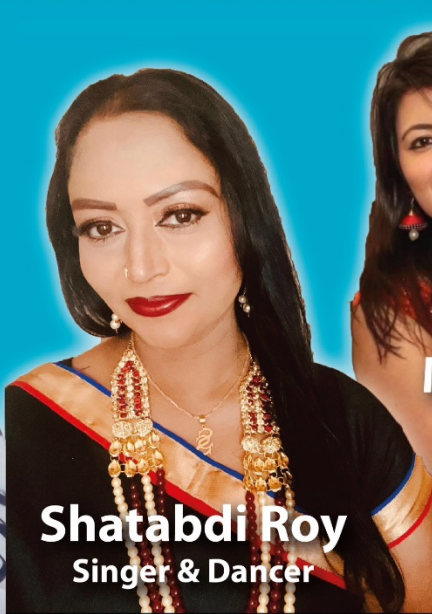

I am writing to let you know about a new community hub that we have created at Swindon Town Football Club.

We have opened this hub to enable people to pop in for toast and a cuppa in the morning, we open 8:30 - 10, or if you would rather some lunch and a cuppa from 12 - 2.

Everything food and drink wise at the hub has been donated and is free, you can come along, have something and chat with our volunteers or you can just enjoy your food and drink on your own table, the choice is completely yours.

At the moment, we offer toast for breakfast, white or brown and assorted spreads, jams, peanut butter and marmalade. For lunch we have various pot noodles, pasta pots, naked noodle pots and cuppa soups. There are also biscuits and chocolate bars available. Once we get the hub established and we know the demand we will look to expand the foods offered.
