
Reading

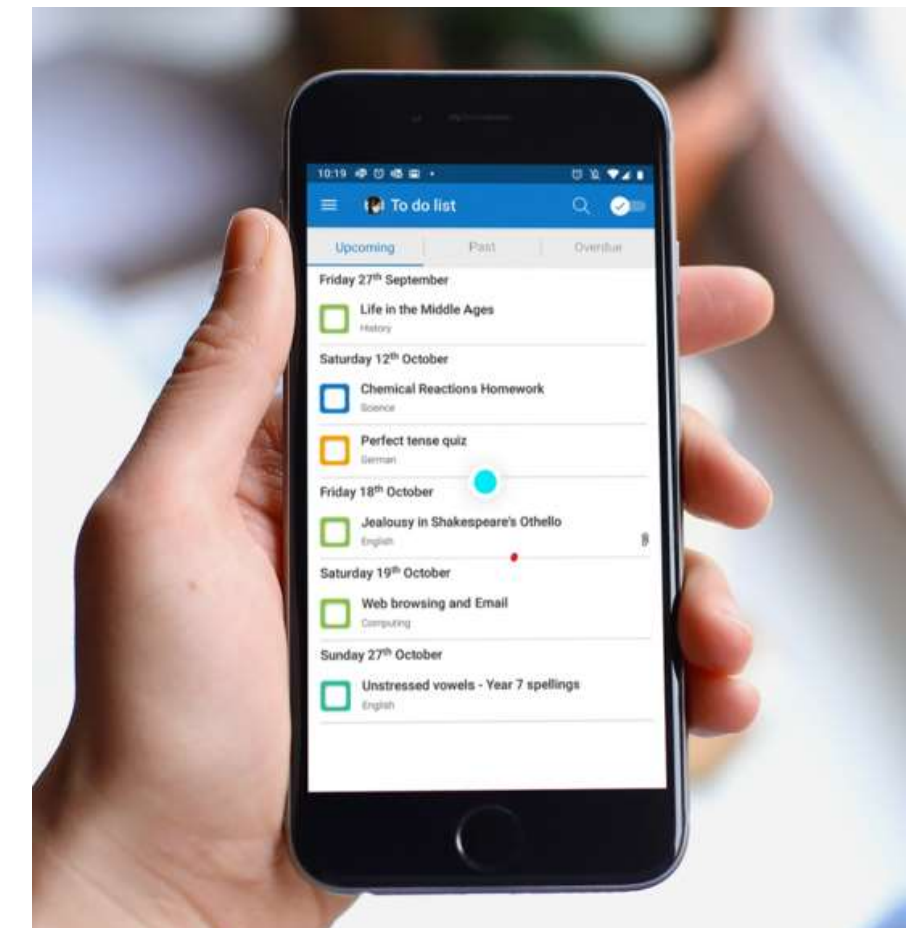

90% sounds pretty **good** when it's a test mark,

but...

90% attendance = **½ day missed** every week!

1 school year at **90%** attendance = **4** whole weeks of lessons **MISSED!**

5 school years at **90%** attendance = **½ a school year MISSED!**

Unmissable

The link between attendance and attainment is clear:

In 2023/24, just 35% of Persistent Absent (PA) children in Key Stage 4 (KS4) got 9 to 4 in their English and Maths GCSEs, compared with 63% of regular attenders.

Unmissable



- Registers are taken every lesson
- Parents/carers to report their child's absence to school
- Parents/carers notified if their child is not in school
- Emails and texts home
- Very close partnership between school and home
 - 'School Attendance Meetings' are regularly held
- Term-time holidays are not authorised
- 2-week holiday in October 2026

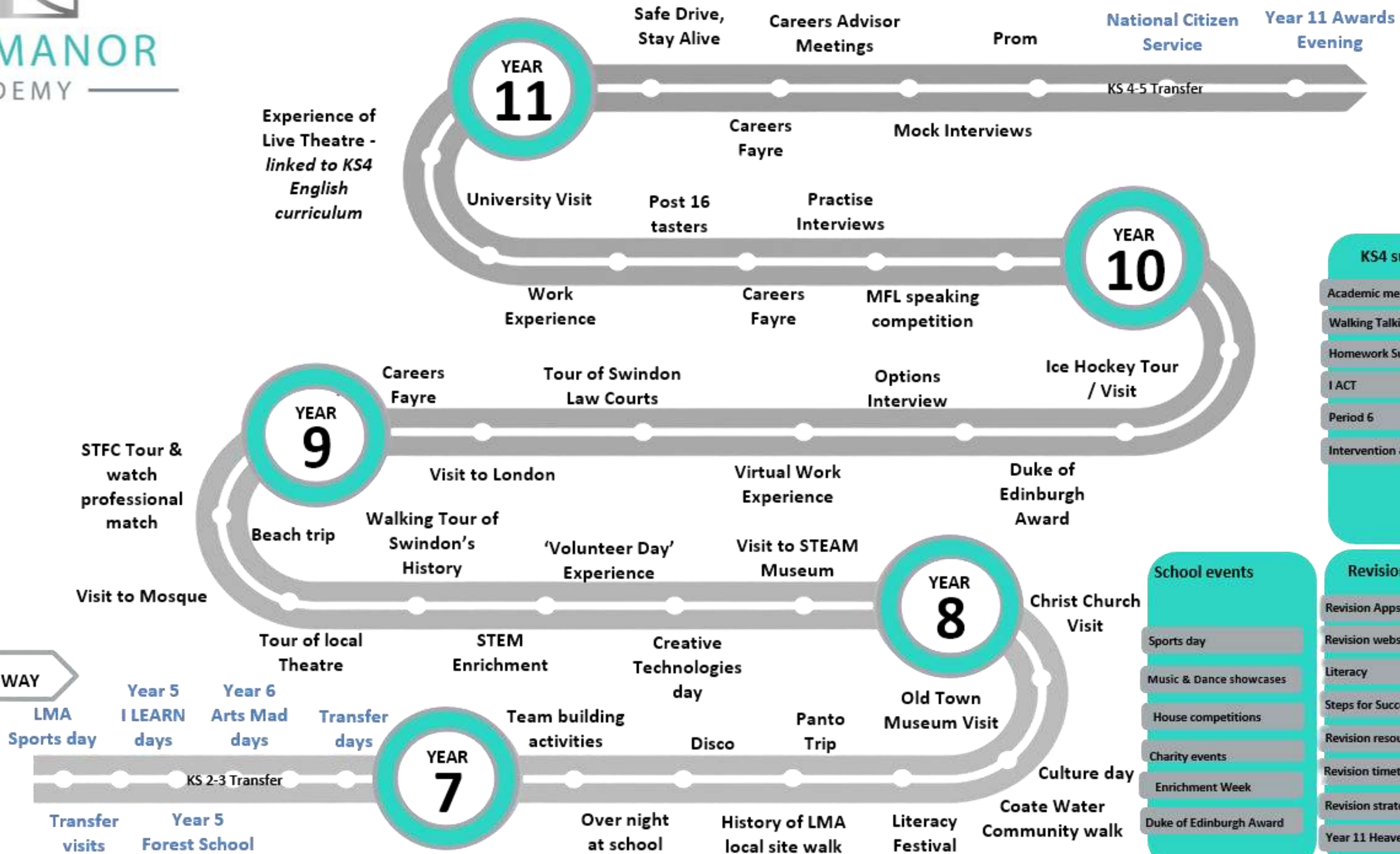

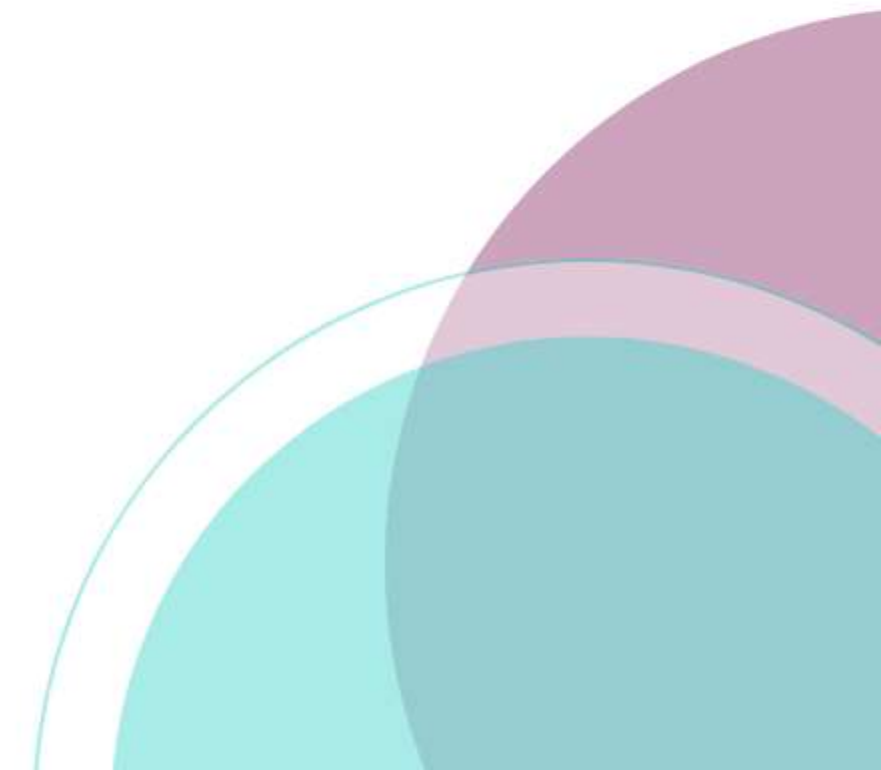
